Notre histoire is a web-based curriculum series by Voces Digital that builds students' language proficiency and intercultural competency using the Comprehensible-Input approach to language acquisition, an approach that includes oral, written, and visual storytelling. Cultural Integration

Vibrant cultural images of products, practices, and perspectives from the francophone world pique students' curiosity. Included activities teach students to notice cultural similarities and differences, draw conclusions, or make inferences about the evidence they see. With increased proficiency, students learn to ask questions and wonder about what life is like in other parts of the francophone world.

Building Proficiency

Notre histoire also includes real-world authentic texts (for native speakers, by native speakers) paired with communicative performance tasks that aim to increase students' proficiency in reading, listening, speaking, and writing. Each communicative task is matched to a Can-Do statement, where students can self-reflect and set personal goals on their road to higher levels of proficiency.
